Greetings to all the Churches, Pastors and Friends in the Gospel,

In March and August, we took nationals from all over the world to visit churches in West Virginia and North Carolina. We are away from home for about a month with this part of the ministry. I also take four trips to a certain Hispanic country each year, and sometimes go to other Spanish speaking countries. Please pray for my wife, as this takes me away from home quite a bit.



When home I am usually preaching on the weekends and sometimes in other states. This is necessary, to continue our ministry in a specific Hispanic country, as we present and bring updates while preaching in our supporting churches. We have had some great services this year! GOD IS SO GOOD!!
